

DRESS CODE

There is a dress code at Brawerman Elementary School, and all students are expected to dress accordingly. Clothing should be clean, appropriately sized and in good repair.

Wear only:

- Brawerman logo on any clothing item.
- Collared, solid color white, navy blue or gray shirts.
- Navy blue, gray or khaki solid colored pants, shorts, skirts, skorts or jumpers.
(Jeans, sweats or athletic shorts may not be worn.) Shorts, skirts and jumpers **are required to be no shorter than 3” above the top of the knee, even when worn with leggings. (Leggings may not be worn in place of pants or skirts.)**
- Solid colored white, gray, blue or black athletic shoes with shoelaces or Velcro. (No boots, sandals or slip-on shoes may be worn.)
- Solid colored navy blue, white or gray socks or tights.
- Solid colored navy blue, khaki or gray outerwear (jackets, sweaters or sweatshirts).
- School logo wear or solid color (navy blue or gray) sweatshirts.

Students may NOT wear:

- Hats inside the classroom.
- Nail polish or make-up.
- Dyed hair or hairstyles that detract from the academic environment.
- Brawerman t-shirts as part of the dress code, (but they may be worn on free dress days and for sport-related activities.)
- Dangling earrings or excessive jewelry.

Please Note:

- **Students are expected to wear white shirts on Friday in honor of Shabbat.**
- On free dress days, students are expected to wear school shoes and clothing appropriate to our school environment.
- On field trips, students are expected to dress in a manner that represents our school appropriately. Students must wear dress code shirts or Brawerman t-shirts.

Parents will be called if the above standards are not met. Students will be required to return home to change into more suitable attire.

- An extra set of labeled clothes (underwear, socks, pants and shirt) **MUST** be sent the first week of school in a labeled zipped plastic bag to be used **in case of an emergency.**
- **All articles of clothing must be clearly labeled with your child’s name and room number.**
- Lost items will be placed in the Lost & Found located under the stairs adjacent to the west Kindergarten entrance door. Please have your child check lost and found; unclaimed items will be donated at the end of each month.
